## **HEDYCHIUM**

Koenig in Retz., Obs. 3:73.1783.

Terrestrial or epiphytic herbaceous plants. Leafy stem 50 cm to 3 m tall. Leaves distichous, elliptic, oblong or elliptic-oblong, rarely linear or lanceolate-oblong, sessile or shortly petiolate on the sheath, glabrous or hairy beneath; ligules membranous, (0.1-)1-5(-10) cm long. Inflorescences terminal on leafy stem, erect or eccentric; bracts broad or narrow, spirally arranged on the rachis, lax or closely imbricate, subtending 1 to 6 (up to 11 flowers in H. stenopetalum); bracteoles tubular or folded. Calvx tubular, slender, apex acute or unequally 2. to 3. toothed, often deeply divided along one side. Corolla-tube long and slender, lobes linear. Staminodes petaloid, broad or narrow. Labellum narrow at base or clawed, the blade broad with several shapes, more or less deeply divided. Stamen: filament slender, shorter or longer than the labellum; anther linear, rarely saggittate. Ovary glabrous or hairy, trilocular, placenta axile; ovules numerous. Fruit loculicidal capsule. Seeds many arrilate.
