1. Curcuma alismatifolia Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. xlix. (1903). 259.

Rhizome hardly developed, root stock about 1.5 cm wide, roots bearing tubers. Leaves ca 4. Bladeless sheaths ca 3, 4-14 cm long. glabrous. Blades linear, sometimes oblanceolate-linear, 18-28(-40), apex acute, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Leaf-sheaths 12-18 cm long, petiole 2-4 cm long, 18-37, glabrous, Ligule membranous, small, rounded, ca 1 mm long, glabrous. Inflorescence central, peduncle 33-78 cm long, spike 10-17 x 2-4 cm. Bracts: coma bracts pink with greenish tip, elliptic, 5-6 x 2-3 cm, apex acute; flower bracts greenish tinted with purple, obovate, 3-3.5 x 3-3.5 cm, apex truncate and shortly mucronate, glabrous. Bracteoles ovate, acute, 6.5 x 4 mm. Calyx white, ca 8 mm long, 3lobed, glabrous. Corolla-tube 2 mm long, glabrous, dorsal lobe 1.1 x 0.8 cm, hooded, lateral lobes 1.1 x 0.6 cm. Staminodes white, lanceolate, 1.7 x 0.7 cm, apex acute. *Labellum* purple with yellow median stripe, elliptic, 1.7 x 1.4 cm, apex bilobed, margin crinckled. Stamen: filament 4x 3 mm, anther 5 mm long, anthercrest ca 1 mm long, spurs absent. Ovary 2.5-3 x 2 mm, glabrous; stylodes lacking.

2. Curcuma amada Roxb. in As. Res. xi. (1810). 341. (described from Y 20058803, and Max 74-649)

Rhizome branched, elongate, 2-2.5 cm thick, white with pleasant smell. Leaves 4-7. Blades elliptic-oblong, 51-68 x 12-22 cm, apex long acuminate, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Leaf-sheaths c 34 cm long, petiole c 20 cm long, finely hairy. Ligule rounded, ca 5 cm long, hairy. Inflorescence central, peduncle 11-40 cm long, spike 11-24 x 2.5-4 cm. Bracts lanceolate, 4.5 x 2.5 cm, apex acute, both surfaces pubescent. Bracteoles folded, unequal sided, after open 3.2 x 1.1 cm, outside hairy. Calyx 0.8-1.3 cm long, 3-lobed, sparsely hairy. Corolla-tube hairy or glabrescent 2 cm long, dorsal-lobe 1.5 x 0.9 cm, lateral lobes narrower, apex rounded. Staminodes oblong, 1.6 x 0.7 cm, apex rounded. Labellum obovate-oblong, 2 x 1.3 cm, apex bilobed. Stamen: filament 5 x 3-5 mm, anther 4 mm long, no crest, spurs ca 2 mm long. Ovary ca 5 x 3 mm, densely hairy; stylodes 3-4 mm long.

3. Curcuma angustifolia Roxb. in As. Res. xi.(1810). 338. t. 3.

Rhizome not branched, root stock c 1-2 cm wide, 3-4 cm long. Leaves 2-4. Bladeless sheaths ca 3, sparsely hairy and ciliate. Blades oblong or linear, 22-45 x 2.5-6 cm, apex long acuminate. base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Leaf-sheaths 10-15 cm long. petiole 2-4 cm long, glabrous. Ligule very short, hairy. Inflorescence laterally attached to the leafy shoot; peduncle 4-18 cm long, spike 7-13 x 2.5-4 cm. Bracts oblong, ca $3.5 \times 2.5 \text{ cm}$. apex rounded or broadly acute. Bracteoles oblong, ca 7 x 2.5 mm, acute, slightly hooded. Calvx 7 mm long, trilobed, margins hyaline. glabrous. Corolla-tube 2.3 cm long, dilated upward, outside glabrous, throat hairy, dorsal lobe 8 x 8 mm, apex shortly mucronate; hooded, lateral lobes oblong, 7 x 4 mm, apex rounded, slightly hooded. Staminodes oblong, 9 x 5 mm, apex rounded. Labellum suborbicular, 10 x 11 mm, apex bilobed. Stamen: filament 3 mm long, glabrous; anther without crest, ca 3 mm long, spurs 1.5-2 mm long, glabrous. Ovary 3 x 2 mm, long hairy; stylodes 3 mm long.

4. Curcuma attenuata Wall. Cat. no. 6602.

Rhizome not branched, root stock small. Leaves 2-4. Blades elliptic-oblong or linear, 21-61 x 4.5-8 cm, apex long acuminate or acicular, base cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower hairy or glabrescent, at least at the apex. Petiole 1-5 cm long, glabrous; leaf-sheaths 15-25 cm long, hairy. Ligule inconspicuous, 1-2 mm long, hairy. Inflorescence central; peduncle 11-42 cm long, spike 10-18 x 3-5 cm. Bracts elliptic, 2.8 x 1.8 cm, apex broadly acute. Bracteoles oblong, 1.2 x 0.4 cm, apex hooded, ciliate. Calyx 6 cm long, unequally 3-lobed, glabrous or sparsely hairy, ciliate. Corolla-tube 2.1 cm long, glabrous, except the upper part sparsely hairy, dorsal lobe oblong, 1.1 x o.8 cm, apex mucronate, hooded; lateral lobes oblong, 1.0 x 0.5 cm, apex rounded. Staminodes ovate-oblong, 1.3 x 0.6 cm, apex rounded. Labellum subelliptic, 1.4 x 1.2 cm, apex bilobed, inside hairy. Stamen: filament broad, ca 4.5 mm long; anther without crest, 3 mm long, spurs acute, 2 mm long. Ovary 2 x 1 mm, long hairy; stylodes ca 3 mm long.

5. Curcuma aurantiaca van Zijp in Rec. Trav. Bot. Neerl. xii. (1915). 345.

Rhizome short, or hardly developed. Leaves 2-5, Blades ellipticoblong or oblong, 28-46 x 7-15 cm, apex long acuminate or acicular, base rounded upper surface glabrous, lower surface pubescent. Petiole c15 cm long, leaf-sheaths c 20 cm long. Ligule triangular, ca 5 mm long, hairy. *Inflorescence* central; peduncle 10-30 cm long, spike cylindrical, 10-21 x 3-4 cm. Bracts both surfaces pubescent: coma bracts 6.5 x 2.4 cm, apex rounded with mucronate; flower bracts oblong, 5 x 3 cm, apex rounded and reflexed. Bracteoles 6-8 mm long, hairy. Calyx ca 1 cm long, hairy. Corolla-tube 1-1.2 cm long, glabrous, dorsal lobe oblong, 1.7 x 1 cm, apex mucronate, hooded, outside hairy; lateral lobes oblong, 1.5 x 0.7 cm, apex rounded, slightly hooded, outside hairy. Staminodes elliptic, 1.8 x 1 cm, apex rounded, margins ciliate, inside hairy. Labellum cuneate-ovate or clawed-ovate, 2.4 x 1.7 cm, apex bilobed, margin ciliate, throat hairy. Stamen: filament broad, 8 x 3 mm, glabrous; anther hairy, without spurs, ca 4 mm long, anther-crest ca 1 mm long, ciliate. Ovary ca 3 x 1.5 mm, densely pubescent. Capsule 1.2 x 0.6 cm.

6. Curcuma cochinchinensis Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. liv. (1907). 404.

Rhizome small, about 0.5 cm wide, (from the dry spec.) covered by papery, light brownish scales. Bladeless sheaths 2-3, glabrous, ciliate, 6-12 cm long. Leaves ca 2. Blades oblong or elliptic-oblong, rarely lanceolate, 22-24 x 5.5-6.5 cm, apex acute, base cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower hairy. Petiole 1-3 cm long, leaf sheath 7-9 cm long, hairy. Ligule rounded, hairy, ca 3 mm long. Inflorescence central, rarely laterally attached to the tuft; peduncle 3-10 cm, spike 4-8 x 2-4 cm. Bracts finely hairy: coma bracts none, flower bracts elliptic, ca 4 x 2.4 cm, the inner ones slightly smaller, apex broadly acute. Bracteoles ca 2 x 0.5 mm. Calyx ca 1.4 cm long, tri-lobed, lobes obtuse. Corolla-tube 1.8-2 cm, hairy, dorsal lobe 2x 0.8 cm, hooded; lateral lobes 1.4 x 0.5 cm, slightly hooded. Staminodes elliptic, apex rounded, 2 x 1.1 cm Labellum elliptic, 1.9 x 1.2 cm, apex emarginate. Stamen: filament 5 x 6 mm; anther 5.5 mm, anther-crest rounded, ca 1 x 1 mm, spurs very small, ca 1 mm long or shorter. Ovary ca 2.5 cm long, hairy; stylodes ca 4 mm long.

7. Curcuma ecomata Craib in Kew Bull. (1912). 301.

Rhizome not elongate, bearing tubers. Bladeless sheaths 10-14 cm long, glabrous, ciliate. Leaves 2-4. Blades elliptic-oblong, 27-35 x 6-11 cm, apex acuminate, base cuneate. Petiole with sheath (15-)22-30(-38) cm. Ligule inconspicuous, membranous. Inflorescence from leafless rhizome, covered with 3-4 bladeless sheaths, peduncle (3-)5-7(-12) cm, spike ellipsoid or ovate, 5-8 x 3-4 cm. Bracts:coma bracts none; flower bracts ovate, broadly acute, ca 3 x 2.2 cm, glabrous, margin hyaline. Bracteoles? Calyx ca 1.5- 2.0 cm long, 3-lobed, glabrous. Corolla-tube ca 2.7-3 cm long, hairy, dorsal lobe 1.5-1.9 x 0.6 cm, apex hooded; lateral lobes 1.5 x 0.6 cm. Staminodes elliptic, 1.5-1.8 x 0.8 cm, acute, inside hairy. Labellum ovate-cuneate, bilobed, 1.4-1.8 x 1.0-1.2 cm. Stamen: filament 7 x 2 mm, anther ca 7 mm long, anther crest ca 1 mm long, spurs ca 3 mm long. Ovary 3-4 x 2 mm, hairy.

8. Curcuma gracillima Gagnep. in Bull Soc. Bot. Fr. l. (1903). 161. (descr. from Put 2874)

Rhizome small, hardly developed. Leaves 2-4 in a tuft. Blades elliptic-oblong, 10-16 x 1.5 cm, apex mucronate, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous except apex hairy, greenish with purple stripe along the midrib. Petiole with leaf sheath 8-12 cm long, glabrous. Bladeless sheaths 3-4, 2-10 cm long, apex mucronate, glabrous. Leaf sheaths 6-8 cm long, glabrous. Ligule membranous, 2x 1 mm, apex rounded, glabrous. Inflorescence central, peduncle slender, 9-18 cm long; spike 2-3 x 1-2 cm. Bracts glabrous: coma bracts purple, oblong, 1-2 x 0.5-1 cm, apex mucronate; flower bracts 1.2-1.5 x 1.0 cm.

9. Curcuma harmandii Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. liv. (1907). 404.

Rhizome unbranched, root stock 1.5 x 1 cm, white inside. Roots bearing ellipsoid tubers. Leaves ca 3. Bladeless sheaths 15-17 cm long. Blades dark green, elliptic, ca 16 x 7 cm, apex acute to acuminate, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. petiole 5-8(-13) cm long.leaf-sheaths14-20 cm long cm long. Ligule membranous, minute, apex rounded. Inflorescence central, peduncle 12 cm long, spike ca 14 cm long. Bracts: coma bracts none, flower bracts dark green, lanceolate, with upper half suddently narrowed to acute apex, ca 6 cm long, the widest part ca 3.5 cm, both surfaces glabrous. Bracteoles elliptic to ovate, 1 x 0.8 cm, apex rounded. Calyx white, 8 mm long, 3-lobed, deeply divided along one side, glabrous. Corolla white, tube 2.5 cm long, glabrous; dorsal lobe oblong, 1.2 x 0.8, apex rounded and hooded; lateral lobes oblong, 1 x 0.7 cm, apex rounded, slightly hooded. Staminodes white, linear, 1.5 x 0.15 cm. Labellum white with pink median stripes. Stamen: filament ca 2.5 x 2.5 mm; anther 4 mm long, anther crest truncate, 3 mm long. Ovary 3 x 2 mm, glabrous; stylodes lacking.

10. Curcuma longa L. Sp. Pl. ed. i. (1753) 2.

Rhizome elongate branched, dark yellow to orange. Leaves several. Blades elliptic-oblong, 65-90 x 13-17 cm, apex acuminate, base long cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Leaf-sheaths c 30 cm long. Petiole sparsely hairy, c12 cm long. Inflorescence central. Peduncle 10-15 cm long, spike 13-16(-20) x 4-6 cm. Bracts: coma bracts greenish-white, slightly purplish at the apex, oblong, apex broadly acute, 6.0 x 2.5 cm, both sides

finely hairy, flower bracts pale greenish, oblong or slightly obovate, 4.5 x 3.0 cm, apex rounded, almost truncate, both sides finely hairy, except the lower part of tyhe inside bracts. *Bracteoles* keeled, obovate-oblong, both sides glabrous, apex rounded, ciliate. *Calyx* white, 1 cm long, 3-lobed, truncate, deeply divided on one side. *Corolla* pale yellow to white, tube 3.2 cm long, lateral lobes 1.3 x 0.8 cm, apex rounded, dorsal lobe 1.4 x 1.0 cm, acuminate, hooded. *Staminodes* pale yellow, oblong. 1.3 x 0.9 cm. *Labellum* pale yellow, darker yellow at the middle band, obovate-oblong, 3-lobed, middle lobe bifid, 2.2 x 1.6 cm. *Stamen*: filament 5 x 3 mm, anther thick, 3.5 mm long, spurs 3 mm long. *Ovary* white, 4.0 x 2.5 mm, hairy; stylodes c 3.5 mm long.

11. Curcuma parviflora Wall. Pl. As. Rar. I. (1830). 47. t. 57. (descr. flower from Max 74-865)

Rhizome small. Leaves 5-7. Blades elliptic to elliptic-oblong, 8-22 x 3-7 cm, apex acuminate, base rounded or broadly acute, cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower surface shortly hairy. Petiole 2-10 cm long. Leave sheaths 4-10 cm long, glabrous. Ligule membranous, very short, glabrous, margin ciliate. Inflorescence central, peduncle c. 8 cm long, hairy; spike 6.5 x 3.0 cm. Bracts: coma bracts white, apex often tinted greenish, lanceolate, apex acute, 1.5-4.0 x 0.8-1.8 cm, glabrous; flower bracts greenish, obovate to suborbicular, c. 2.8 x 3.2 cm, apex broadly rounded, almost truncate or slightly mucronate, glabrous, both edges folded inside, apex reflexed. Bracteoles 5-7 x 4-5 mm, glabrous. Calyx c. 4 mm long, glabrous. Corolla-tube c. 1.2 cm long, glabrous, dorsal lobe oblong, 5 x 3 mm, hooded, lateral lobes about the same, apex rounded. Staminodes white, oblanceolate, 8 x 2.5 mm. Labellum purble, oblong or obovate-oblong, 1.0 x 0.7 cm, apex bilobed, margin irregularly crenate. Stamen: filament c. 2 mm long, glabrous; anther c. 1 mm long, anther-crest c. 2 mm long, rounded, spurs absent. Ovary c. 1.5 mm long, glabrous, stylodes lacking.

12. Curcuma petiolata Roxb. Fl. ind. ed. 1.I. (1820). 37. (described from Larsen 31801 and 704)

Rhizome not well developd, roots bearing ellipsoid tubers Leaves ca 7 in a tuft. Blades elliptic or elliptic-oblong, 42-46 x 16-20(-26) cm, apex acuminate, base rounded or subcordate, both surfaces glabrous. Petiole 7-14 cm long, glabrous. Leaf sheaths 21-30 cm

long, glabrous. Ligule membranous, truncate, 2 mm long, glabrous, margin ciliate. *Inflorescence* central, peduncle 25-40 cm long, glabrous, spike 15-18 x 3.5-5 cm. *Bracts*: coma bracts pink, flower bracts greenish. Size of bracts? *Bracteoles*1.8 x 1.4 cm, obovate, apex rounded, slightly hooded. *Calyx* funnel-shaped, ca 8 mm long, 3-lobed, glabrous. *Corolla*-tube 2.2 cm long, dilated to the top;, dorsal lobe ca 1.3 x 0.9 cm, apex mucronate, lateral lobes ca 1.2 x 0.5 cm. *Staminodes* oblong, 1.6 x 0.9 cm, apex rounded. *Labellum* obovate to suborbicular, 1.6 x 1.6 cm, apex bilobed. *Stamen*: filament ca 7 x 5 mm, anther ca 4 mm long, crest none, spurs ca 2 mm long. *Ovary* 2-3 x 2-3 mm, hairy; stylodes ca 3 mm long. Capsule obovoid, 1 x 0.5 cm, sparsely hairy. Seeds ellipsoid, 3.5 x 1 mm, aril white, lacerate.

13. Curcuma plicata Wall. ms. apud Bak. in Hook. f. Fl. Brit. Ind. vi. (1890). 213.

Rhizome short., bearing ellipsoid tubers. Leaves ca 7 in a tuft. Blades elliptic-oblong or oblong and narrowed to both ends, 26-31 x 6-8 cm, apex acuminate, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Bladeless sheaths 5-13 cm long, glabrous. Petiole leaf sheath 20-27 cm long. Ligule 2 mm long, ciliate. Inflorescence central, peduncle 10-25 cm long, spike 9-13 x 3-4 cm, spike 9-13 x 3-4 cm. Bracts: coma bracts purple, flower bracts greenish. Bracteoles oblong, 7 x 4 mm, hairy outside. Calyx ca 1 cm long, unequally 3-lobed, hairy. Corolla-tube 2 cm long, hairy, dorsal lobe oblong, 1.7 x 0.7 cm, mucronate, outside hairy; lateral lobes 1.4 x 0.5 cm, outside hairy. Staminodes clawed-ovate, 1.5 x 0.7 cm, apex obtuse or broadly acute. Labellum oblong or obovate-oblong, 1.5 x 1.1 cm, apex emarginate. Stamen: filament 3 x 2 mm, anther 3 mm long, anther-crest very short or none, spurs ca 2 mm long. Ovary 3-4 x1 mm, hairy.

14. Curcuma roscoeana Wall. Pl. As. Rar. i. (1830). 8. t.9.

Rhizome small. Leaves 3-5 in a tuft. Blades elliptic or elliptic-oblong, 25-40 x 9-16 cm, apex acuminate, base rounded and slightly cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Bladeless sheaths 13-40 cm long, glabrous or sparsely hairy, ciliate. Petiole 11-26 cm long, glabrous. Ligule 2-5 mm long, apex rounded, glabrous, ciliate. Inflorescence central, prduncle 7-9 cm long, spike 12 x 4-4.5 cm. Bracts orange, slightly greenish at the base, oblanceolate-oblong or

oblong, 4 cm long, apex rounded, reflexed, glabrous, no coma bracts. *Bracteoles* elliptic, membranous, keeled, 8 x 6 mm, glabrous. *Calyx* white, 2.2 cm long, 3-lobed. *Corolla*-tube white, 3-3.7 cm long, dilated to the top, dorsal lobe 1 x 0.4 cm, apex obtuse, margin hyaline, lateral lobes 1 x 0.4 cm, apex obtuse, margin hyaline. *Staminodes* white, elliptic, 1.4 x 0.7 cm, apex acute or shallowly bilobed, entire. *Labellum* white with yellow midband, 1.8 x 1.5 cm, apex retuse, margin entire. *Stamen*: filament broad, 3 x 3 mm, anther white, crest rounded, often reflexed backward, spurs none. *Ovary* white, 2-2.5 x 1-1.5 mm, glabrous.

15. Curcuma rubescens Roxb. in As. Res. xi. (1810). 336.

Rhizome well developed, white inside. Leaves about 8, greenish except the upper midrib dark red or purple. Blades ellipticoblong, 40-50 x 10-13 cm, apex acuminate, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous; leaf-sheaths dark red throughout, 20-30 cm long; petiole winged,6-12 cm long. Ligule membranous, glabrous,c 3 mm long. Inflorescence separated from the leaf tuft, often appearing before the leaves. Peduncle 14-25 cm long; spike cylindrical. Bracts: coma bracts pink, 6 x 3 cm, flower bracts greenish, 4 x 3.2 cm. Calyx 9 mm long, 3-lobed with truncate apex. Corolla-tube c 3 cm long, dorsal lobe hooded, 1.2 x 1 cm, apex spiny; lateral lobes 1.1 x 0.8 cm. Staminodes yellow, oblong, 1.2 x 0.8 cm. Labellum yellow with darker yellow midband, obovate, 3-lobed, middle lobe retuse. Stamen: filament 6 x 4 mm, anther 4 mm long, spurs c 2 mm long. Ovary c.4 x 2.5 mm, hairy.

16. Curcuma sessilis Gage in Rec. Bot. Surv. India. iii. 106.

Rootstock3-3.5 cm long and 2.5 cm wide, end of fibrous roots with elliptic tubers, both white inside. Leaves 2-3 in a tuft. Blades oblong, narrowed to both ends,22-41 x 4-6 cm, apex acuminate to acicular, base cuneate, both surfaces pubescent. Petiole 1-3(5) cm long, leaf-sheaths 10-16 cm long. Ligule rounded, 2 mm long, densely hairy. Inflorescence developed before the leaves, peduncle (6-)8-12(-18) cm, hairy, spike (6-)8-11(-16) x 2-4 cm. Bracts: coma bracts purple, glabrous or glabrescent, slightly ciliate. flower bracts greenish, glabrous or sparsely hairy. Bracteoles lanceolate, folded, after open ca 1.4 x 6 cm, margin hyaline. Calyx ca 9 mm long, 3-lobed, hairy. Corolla-tube ca 2 cm

long, dorsal lobe 1 x 0.6 cm, apex shortly mucronate, hoded, lateral lobes slightly shorter.

Staminodes oblong, 0.9×0.4 cm, apex rounded. Labelum obovate, 1.4×1.0 cm, apex bilobed. Stamen: filament broad, ca 5 mm long, anther without crest, 3 mm long, spurs 2 mm long. Ovary ca 2.5×2 mm, hairy.

17. Curcuma sparganifolia Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. xlix. (1903). 260. (Fl. described from Max 76-513, AAU)

Rhizome small. Leaves usually 2 in a tuft. Bladeless sheaths 2-3, glabrous, the outermost the shortest, ca 2.5-3.5 cm long, the innermost the longest, ca 8-16 cm long. Petiole glabrous, 3-10 cm long, leaf sheath glabrous, (7-)12-20(-24) cm long. Blade linear, purple cloud along the midrib, 13-32 x 1.5-2.5 cm. Ligule membranous, rounded, 2-3 mm long, glabrous. Inflorescence (Max76-513) central, peduncle (10-)40-50(-56) cm long, spike 3-(the following described from Max 76-513) Bracts 5 x 2-3 cm. glabrous, no coma: lower bracts suborbicular, 2.1 x 2.1 cm, apex rounded, upper bracts oblong, 2.1 x 1.0 cm, apex obtuse. Bracteoles keeled, oblong, 5 x 3-4 mm, glabrous. Calyx ca 4 mm long, unequally trilobed, glabrous. Corolla-tube ca 7 mm long, glabrous; dorsal lobe oblong, 7 x 5 mm, apex hooded and short mucronate, lateral lobes oblong, 6 x 4 mm, apex slightly hooded and rounded. Staminodes obovate-oblong, 1.0 x 0.4 cm, apex rounded. Labellum clawed-obovate, apex emarginate, the blade 4-5 x 6-8 mm, the claw 4-5 mm long. Stamen: filament ca 2 x 1 mm, anther ca 2 mm long, spurs none, anther-crest 1-1.5 mm long, apex broadly acute. Ovary 1.5-2 mm long, glabrous; stylodes lacking. Capsule obovoid, 8 x 5 mm, glabrous.

18. Curcuma stenochila Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. lii. (1903). 543.

Rhizome small, bearing globose tubers. Leaves about 7. Blades elliptic or elliptic-oblong, upper surfsce glabrous, lower hairy. Bladeless sheaths 5-15 cm long, hairy. Petiole 12-18(-22) cm long, leaf-sheaths 15-20 cm long, hairy. Ligule suborbicular, apex rounded, densely hairy. Inflorescence central, peduncle ca 3 cm long, spike 3-4 x 1.2-1.7 cm. Bracts.coma bracts none, flower bracts ovate, 3.5 x 2 cm, apex acuminate, both surfaces hairy. Bracteoles? Calyx ca 2 cm long, hairy, 3-lobed, each lobe acute

and ciliate at apex. *Corolla*-tube 3.8 cm long, hairy; dorsal lobe 2.4 x 0.7 cm, apex acicular, hooded; lateral lobes 2 x 0.6 cm, acute, hooded. *Staminodes* ovate-cuneate or elliptic, 2.2 x 1.1 cm, apex acute, outside hairy. *Labellum* oblong or clawed-obovate, 3.5 x 1.5 cm, apex bilobed, each lobe acute.

Stamen: filament broad, 7 x 4 mm, hairy, anther 9 mm long, crest rounded, 3 mm long, spurs 2 mm long, hairy. Ovary 3 x 2 mm, densely hairy; stylodes slender, acute, 0.5 mm long.

19. Curcuma thorelii Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. liv. (1907). 406. (flower, descr. from Pimchai 003)

Rhizome small, rarely branched. Roots with ellipsoid tubers. Leaves about 5. Blades elliptic-oblong, 12-20 x 3-3.5 cm, apex mucronate, base acute, cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower surface shortly hairy. Petiole 2-9 cm long, sparsely hairy. Leaf sheaths 5.5-12 cm long, glabrous. Ligule membranous, rounded, c. 5 x 3 mm, glabrous. Inflorescence central, peduncle c. 17 cm long, sparsely hairy; spike c. 6.5 x 3.0 cm. Bracts: coma bracts white, elliptic to elliptic-oblong, apex acute, 1.7-3.8 x 0.8-1.9 cm, glabrous, spreaded; flower bracts greenish, obovate, c. 3.0 x 2.4 cm, glabrous, apex rounded. Bracteoles oblong, c. 1.2 x 0.8 cm, apex rounded, glabrous. Calyx 6-8 mm long, glabrous. Corolla-tube 1.2 cm long, glabrous, dorsal lobe c. 8 x 6 mm, laterall lobes c. 7 x 3 mm. Staminodes purple, obovate-cuneate, c. 1.5 x 1.0 cm, apex bilobed, margin irregularly crenate. Labellum white, obovatecuneate, c. 1.5 x 1 cm. Stamen: filament c. 2 mm long and 2 mm wide, glabrous; anther c. 3 mm long, anther-crest 1 mm long, apex rounded, connective hairy, spurs absent. Ovary 2 x 1 mm, glabrous, stylodes lacking.

20. Curcuma trichosantha Gagnep. in Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. liv. (1907). 407. (descr. from Prayad 340,343, Fl. from Geesink)

Rootstock1.5 cm thick. Rhizome short or hardly develope. Leaves usually1. Blades oblong, $24\text{-}28 \times 2.5\text{-}4$ cm, apex acuminate to acicular, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Petiole with sheath ca 12 cm long. Bladeless sheaths about 3, glabrous, ciliate, 2-5(-18) cm long. Leaf sheaths ciliate, ca 11 cm long. Inflorescence separated from the leafy shoot. Peduncle 4-7 cm long, glabrous; spike $3.5\text{-}7 \times 2\text{-}3.5$ cm. Bracts: coma bracts purple, glabrous, oblong, 2.5×1 cm, apex broadly acute; flower bracts greenish,

glabrous, 3.2 x 1.5-2 cm. (flowers described from Geesink 5605, spirit specimen no. 6539 (L)): Calyx 7-8 mm long, unequally trilobed. Corolla-tube ca 1.9 cm long, glabrous; dorsal lobe oblong, 1.1 x 0.7 cm, apex hooded and mucronate, lateral lobes oblong, 1.1 x 0.6 cm, apex rounded. Staminodes oblong, 1.2 x 0.5 cm, apex rounded. Labellum oblong, 1.7 x 1.1 cm, trilobed, the middle lobe emarginate. Stamen: filament 6 x 4 mm, anther 3 mm long, spurs ca 1.5 mm long, no anther-crest. Ovary 2 mm long, glabrous or very sparsely hairy; stylodes 3-4 mm long.

21. Curcuma viridiflora Roxb. Fl. Ind. 1 (1820). 34. Specimens: Max 73-78: BK Kosterman 1145: P, L(2sheets).

Rhizome well developed, orange inside. Leaves about 4. Blades ovate-oblong, 29-36 x 12-28 cm, apex acuminate, base rounded-cuneate, distinct veins on the upper surface, both surfaces glabrous. Bladeless sheaths 13-17 cm long. Leaf sheaths 19-33 cm long. Petiole 11-15 cm long. ligule membrous, rounded, ca 7 mm long, ciliate. Inflorescence central, peduncle 15-24 cm long, spike 13-21 x 4-5 cm. Bracts: coma bracts whitish, finely hairy, apex broadly acute or rounded, c 3-3.5 x 2 cm, flower bracts light green-yellowish, shorter, c 2-2.5 x 1.8-2 cm.

22. Curcuma xanthorhiza Roxb. Fl. Ind. ed. 1. (1820). 25.

Rhizome dark yellow or orange inside. Leaves green with reddish midvein, developed different time from inflorescence. Blades elliptic-oblong, (26-)30-40(-65) x 8-12(-20) cm, apex acuminate, base cuneate, both surface glabrous; leaf sheaths 24-32 cm long, glabrous; petiole very short, slightly winged, glabrous. Ligule ca 1 mm long, glabrous. Inflorescence surrounded by 3-4 bladeless sheaths; peduncle 16-29 cm long, glabrous; spike 12-19 x 4-8 cm. (from Max 74-417). Bracts: coma bracts red and spreading, flower bracts green with reddish tips. Bracteoles folded or keeled, after open, elliptic, 2.4-2.7 x 1.4-1.8 cm, apex broadly acute. Calyx ca 1 cm long, trilobed, truncate, hairy. Corolla-tube ca 3 cm long, hairy, lobes pink-reddish, dorsal lobe 1.6 x 0.9 cm, apex hooded, mucronate and hairy, lateral lobes oblong, 1.3 x 0.9 cm, apex rounded. Staminodes light yellow, oblong, 1.8 x 0.8 cm, apex rounded. Labellum yellow, obovate-oblong, 2 x 1.7 cm, apex emarginate. Stamen: filament 5 mm long, 4 mm wide, anther ca 4

mm long, laterally hairy, spurs ca 3 mm long. Ovary 5 mm long, densely hairy; stylodes ca 5 mm long.

23. Curcuma zedoaria Rosc. Monandr. Pl. (1828).t. 109. (Described from Geesink et al 6624)

Rhizome branched, pale yellow inside. Bladeless sheaths about 4, the shortest 5-8 cm long, the longest 30-35 cm long, glabrous, apex mucronate, hairy. Leaves 1-4. Blades elliptic-oblong, 35-41 x 9-12 cm, apex acuminate, base cuneate, dark green with dark purplish along midnerve. Upper surface glabrous, lower surface glabrous or sparsely hairy, especially near the margins and the apex. Petiole 3-4 cm long, glabrous. Ligule short, ciliate. Leaf sheaths 30-34 cm long, finely hairy. Inflorescence separated from the leaf tuft, often appearing before the leaves. Peduncle 18-27cm long, hairy; spike cylindric and broadened to the apex, 11-19 x 5-6 cm. Bracts: flower bracts greenish, hairy both sides, 4-5 x 2.5 cm, apex rounded, coma bracts more elongate, purplish-pink, 6-7 x 2 cm, hairy both sides. Bracteoles (?) Calyx 8-10 mm long, unequally trilobed, apex rounded or almost truncate, hairy. Corolla-tube 2.5-3 cm long, lobes red, dorsal lobe oblong, 1.8 x 1.4 cm, apex hooded, mucronate and hairy; lateral lobes oblong, 1.6 x 1.2 cm, apex rounded. Staminodes oblong, 1.8 x 0.8-0.9 cm, apex rounded, yellow. Labellum obovate, 2.1 x 1.7 cm, apex emarginate. obscurely trilobed, yellow with dark yellow midrib. Stamen white: filament 6 mm long, anther 4 mm long, laterally hairy, spurs 2 mm long. Ovary 2 mm long, hairy; stylodes 5 mm long.

24. Curcuma cf. albiflora Thw. (unknown1) Specimens: Max. 72-409: BK, 73-78: AAU, 73-480: AAU, BK, 74-629: AAU, BK, 74-699: AAU, BK, L, 75-629: AAU, BK, L

Rootstock ca 3 x 1.5 cm, orange inside, unbranced. Leaves 2-3 in a tuft. Bladeless sheaths about 3, 9-15 cm long, glabrous. *Blades* elliptic-oblong, (18-)25-409-77) x (5-)7-12(-17) cm, apex acuminate to caudate, base cuneate, , both surfaces glabrous. Leaf sheaths 8-25 cm long, glabrous. Petiole 4-9 cm long, glabrous. Ligule thin, very short, glabrous. *Inflorescence* central, peduncle 8-14 cm long, glabrous, spike 7-10(14) x 3-5 cm. *Bracts*: coma bracts none, flower bracts 3-4.5 x 2-3 cm, apex rounded, rarely with short mucronate, glabrous, white. *Bracteoles*? *Calyx* 1.3 cm

long, 3-lobed, deeply divided along one side, lobes rounded or nearly truncate. *Corolla* white, tube 1.8 cm long, funnel-shaped, outside hairy; dorsal lobe triangular, 1.2 x 0.9 cm, apex acuminate and hooded; lateral lobes oblong, 1 x 0.5 cm, apex acute and hooded. *Staminodes* white, clawed: blade ovate, 8 x 6 mm, apex rounded, inside hairy; claw 4 x 4 mm, ciliate. *Labellum* white with yellow midband, suborbicular, 1.2 x 1.2 cm, apex bilobed, each lobe acute, inside hairy, sparsely ciliate. *Stamen*: filament broad, 7 x 4 mm, hairy at the back; anther linear, 3.5 mm long, crest ca 0.5 mm long, spurs ca 1.5 mm long, connective hairy. *Ovary* 2 x 2 mm, glabrous; stylodes cylindrical, acute, ca 4 mm long.

25. Curcuma cf. oligantha Trimen (unknown 2)

Specimens: Kerr 5896: BK, K; 21454: BK, K Max 72-297: BK Somran s.n. (Chula)

Rhizome slender. Leaves few, usually 1, surrounded by several blade less sheaths. Blades elliptic-oblong, rarely lanceolate, 9-13(18) x 2-4.5 cm, apex acuminate, base acute or cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower surface hairy. Bladeless sheaths ca 4, sparsely hairy. Leaf sheaths (?) Petiole(?) Ligule (?) Inflorescence separated from the leafy shoot, peduncle (length?), glabrous or sparsely hairy near the base of spike, spike 3-6 x 2 cm. Bracts coma bracts none, flower bracts lanceolate, 5.2 x 2.2 cm, apex acute, inside hairy, margin ciliate. Bracteoles (?) Flowers white. Calyx 2.5 cm long, 3-lobed, glabrous, apex ciliate. Corolla-tube 3 cm long, dilated to the top, outside hairy; dorsal lobe oblong, apex acuminate, hooded; lateral lobes oblong, 2 x 0.6 cm, apex acute, hooded. Staminodes elliptic, 2.5 x 1.4 cm, apex broadly acute, base shortly clawed, inside hairy. Labellum elliptic or nearly obovate with emarginate-acute apex, 2.2 x 1.6 cm, inside glandular hairy. Stamen: filament broad, 4 mm long; anther linear, 8 mm long, crest none, spurs petaloid and succulent, 5 mm long and 1 mm wide. Ovary 3 x 2 mm, densely hairy; stylodes filiform, 0.9 mm long, apex acute.

26. Curcuma aff. oligantha Trimen (unknown 3)
Specimens: Collins 1086: C, K
Max 75-413: AAU, BK, L; 75-625: AAU, L; 76-161:
AAU, BK, L

Rhizome small, c 5-6 mm wide, white, root stock c 2 cm wide. Leafy shoot ca 50 cm tall. Leaves few, usually appeared after the inflorescence. Blades elliptic-oblong, 19-34 x 6-8 cm, apex acuminate, base acute or cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower surface pubescent. Bladeless sheaths purplish, 6-25 cm long, glabrous, apex mucronate and hooded. Petiole 3-8 cm long, glabrous, leaf-sheaths purplish, 13-22 cm long, glabrous. Ligule inconspicuous, truncate, ca 2 mm long, glabrous. Inflorescence usually without leaves, surrounded by severall blabeless sheaths, peduncle 5-12 cm long, spike (?) Bracts: coma bracts none, flower bracts lanceolate, 4.5-6 x 2.2 cm. apex acuminate and often reflexed backward, both sides glabrous. Bracteoles narrowed, linear, folded, after open 1.8 x 0.15 cm, apex hooded. Flowers white. Calyx 2.5 cm long, 3-lobed, deeply divided along one side, glabrous. Corolla-tube 3.8 cm long, hairy; dorsal lobe oblong, 2.7 x 0.7 cm, apex cuspidate, hooded; lateral lobes oblong, 2 x 0.7 cm, apex shortly mucronate, hooded. Staminodes elliptic, 2.8 x 1.3 cm, apex rounded, inside hairy. Labellum white with a yellow midband, elliptic, 2.7 x 1.8 cm, apex emarginate, inside hairy. Stamen: filament broad and short, ca 2 x 3 mm; anther linear, ca 6 mm long, crest very short or none, spurs ca 5 mm long, petaloid. Ovary 4 x 1.5 mm, glabrous; stylodes linear, acute, ca 6 mm long. Fruit obovoid, calyx persistent, 1.5 x 0.8 cm, seeds with white aril, ca 4 x 1.5 mm, elipsoid.

27. Curcuma sp. (unknown 4) Specimens: Larsen 30750: AAU, K Niyomdham 1246: AAU, BKF, K

Rhizome (?) Leaves (from the specimen, seen only 1 leaf). Blades elliptic or elliptic-oblong, $35-50 \times 19-24 \text{ cm}$, apex long acuminate, base rounded, slightly cuneate or subcordate, both surfaces glabrous. Bladeless sheaths ca 14 cm long. Leaf sheaths 19-24 cm long, hairy. Petiole 11-18 cm long,

hairy. Ligule densely hairy, apex acute, 5-6 cm long. *Inflorescence* central, peduncle 10-15 cm long, hairy; spike 14-18 x 4-6 cm.

Bracts: coma bracts purple, flower

bracts greenish tinted with red. Flowers orange. Calyx 9 mm long,

unequally 3-lobed, apex ciliate. *Corolla*-tube 2.8 cm long, funnel-shaped; dorsal lobe 1.7 x 1 cm, apex mucronate, hooded, ciliate; lateral lobes oblong, 1.5 x 0.6 cm, apex rounded or broadly acute. *Staminodes* oblong, 1.5 x 0.75 cm, apex rounded. *Labellum* ovate-cuneate, 1.4 x 1.4 cm, 3-lobed, middle lobe emarginate-acute. *Stamen*: filament broad, 6 x 4 mm; anther 6 mm long, crest minute or none, spurs thick, triangular, acute, 1.5 mm long and 1 mm broad. *Ovary* 2 x 1 mm, densely hairy.

28. Curcuma cf. stenochila Gagnep. (unknown 5) Specimen: Obchan Thaithong 1241 (PS 1419), plant from Chantaburi, selling at Chatuchak market

Rhizome small, inside pale yellow, bearing ovoid tubers. Leaves ca 5. Bladeless sheaths none (?) Blades elliptic, 19-26 x 10-12 cm, apex acuminate, base cordate, both surfaces glabrous. Leaf sheaths sparsely hairy, 7.5-10.5 cm; petiole glabrescent, 8-14 cm long. Ligule triangular, acute, 6 mm long, densely hairy. Inflorescence central, peduncle 5-6 cm long, hairy; spike 7 x 4-5 cm. Bracts bright red, outside sparsely hairy: coma bracts none; flower bracts ovate or triangular, 4-5 x 2-2.5 cm, apex acute. Bracteoles white, ca 2 cm long, 3-lobed, apex rounded or retuse, ciliate. Corolla-tube yellow, ca 3 cm long, lobes yellow tipped with red; dorsal lobe oblong, 1.4-1.8 x 0.5-0.6 cm, apex mucronate; lateral lobes oblong, about the same sizes as the dorsal ones, apex broadly acute. Staminodes yellow, lanceolate, 1.6 x 1.0 cm, apex acute with dark red spot. Labellum yellow tipped with red, clawed-ovate, blade 1.0 x 1.3 cm, apex deeply bilobed, claw 0.5 cm long. Stamen: filament 4 mm long, anther 7 mm long, anthercrest rounded, 2 mm long, spurs 3 mm long. Ovary 4 x 2 mm, hairy; stylodes 6 mm long.

29. Curcuma cf.sparganifolia Gagnep. (unknown 6)

Rhizome short. Leaves ca 4 in a tuft. Bladeless sheaths 1 or 2, ca 9 cm long, glabrous. *Blades* elliptic to elliptic-oblong, $15-22 \times 3-6$ cm, apex acuminate, base cuneate, both surfaces glabrous. Leaf

sheaths 10- 15(-21) cm long, glabrous. Petiole (2-)3-5(-10) cm long, glabrous. Ligule membrabrous, truncate, ca 1 mm long, glabrous. *Inflorescence* central, peduncle 45-60(-90) cm long, spike 4-6 x 2-3 cm. *Bracts*:coma bracts elongate, erect, purplish; flower bracts shorter, keeled, reflexed backward,purplish-greenish. Flower purplish. *Calyx* 5-6 mm long, unequally trilobed. *Corolla*-tube ca 1.2 cm long, dorsal lobe oblong, 1.3 x 0.6 cm, apex hooded and rounded, lateral lobeslanceolate, 1.3 x 0.35 cm, apex acute. *Staminodes* oblong, apex acute, ca 1.2 x 0.5 cm. *Labellum* obovate-oblong, apex bilobed, ca 1.3 x 0.7 cm. *Stamen*: filament broad, ca 1 mm long, 2 mm wide; anther ca 4 mm long, anthercrest very short, ca 0.5 mm long, spurs none. *Ovary* ca 2 mm long, glabrous.

30. Curcuma sp. aff. sumatrana Miq. (unknown 7)

Specimen: Chula s. n. Tak Province (same as list no. 29, sp. nov. 2)

Rhizome elongate, slender. Leaves ca 4. Bladeless sheaths 1-2, the longest one ca 18 cm long, finely hairy. Blades elliptic-oblong, 50-57 x 18-22 cm, apex long acuminate to acicular, base cuneate, upper surface glabrous, lower surface glabrous except on main veins. Leaf sheaths 30-45 cm long, finely hairy. Petiole 19-24 cm long. Ligule membranous, 1 mm long, rounded, ciliate. Inflorescence central, peduficle 17-19 cm long, spike10-14 x 5-6 cm. Bracts: coma bracts none; flowers red, obovate, 4-5 x 3-3.5 cm. Bracteoles white with red apex, broadly elliptic, 3-3.5 x 1.5-2.2 cm. Calyx white, 9 mm long, 3-lobed, sparsely hairy. Corollatube yellow, to constrictin 2 cm long, throat 0.5 cm long, lobes yellow tinted with red; dorsal lobe oblong, 1.7 x 1.1 cm, hooded with mucronate apex; lateral lobes oblong, 1.5 x 1.0 cm, slightly hooded with rounded apex. Staminodes yellow, subelliptic or obovate, 2.0 x 0.9 cm. Labellum yellow with yellow-orange midband, subelliptic or suborbicular, 1.6 x 1.7 cm, 3-lobed, and emarginate. Stamen: filament 5 x 4 mm; anther 4 mm long, anther-crest 1 mm or shorter, spurs ca 3 mm long. Ovary 2 x 1.5 mm, hairy; stylodes ca 4 mm long.
