INTRODUCTION

The Field Crop Project at the Faculty of Natural Resources, Prince of Songkla University, Songkhla, was initiated in 1980 as a sub-project of the Cropping System Project. The aim of the project was to gather information relating to the cultural practice of certain field crops. The crops are very common in the agricultural systèms of other regions of the country outside the South.

This report presents the results of research undertaken during 1980-81. All experiments were basic in nature but seemed important for future research on these crops and for extension service as well.
